HVAC Tune-Up Documentation Requirements

- List of HVAC inventory including location of unit, make/model, and number of compressors (single or multi).
- Invoice detailing work performed to identify tune-up items, as well as additional labor and parts to improve/repair air conditioner or heat pump performance:
 - Condenser Cleaning (required)
 - Evaporator Cleaning
 - Refrigerant Charge Correction ($\leq 20\%$ of refrigerant capacity)
 - Refrigerant Charge Correction ($> 20\%$ of refrigerant capacity)
 - Combo: Condenser Cleaning, Evaporator Cleaning, Charge Correction ($\leq 20\%$)
 - Combo: Condenser Cleaning, Evaporator Cleaning, Charge Correction ($> 20\%$)

HVAC Tune-Up Measure Details

- Air conditioners or heat pumps up to 20 tons nameplate capacity (Units over 20 tons acceptable only after FirstEnergy review and approval)
- Incentive:
 - \$175 = single compressor unit
 - \$250 = multi compressor unit
- Each unit is eligible for a tune-up incentive once during the five (5) year program timeline

HVAC Tune-Up: 180 Days Look Back

- Units tuned-up within the last 180 days may also be eligible for incentive
